RESOLUTION NO. 229-10

DESIGNATING LT. RICHARD A. HAINES MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

Legislator Gardner offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the late Richard A. Haines, from Haines Falls, New York, was born on April 28, 1903; he attended Hunter-Tannersville School; then the Tennessee Military Institute from 1921-1923; he also attended the Naval Academy for a time and he served in the Coast Guard from 1928-1931; and

WHEREAS, Richard A. Haines entered military service on July 23rd, 1941 at which time he was commissioned a Lieutenant in the Naval Reserve; he served in Washington, after which he was assigned to the cruiser USS New Orleans and he honorably served his country during World War II; and

WHEREAS, When the USS New Orleans suffered a devastating torpedo hit on November 30th, 1942 in the Battle of Tassafaronga in the Solomon Islands, Lieutenant Haines remained at his station to assist in controlling the damage until he was overcome by asphyxiating gas generated by the explosion; and

WHEREAS, In the true tradition of the Navy, Richard A. Haines gave his life to save his shipmates and he was posthumously awarded the Purple Heart and the Navy Cross for his heroism; and

WHEREAS, In honor of Lieutenant Haines' memory, on December 27, 1943, the destroyer escort "USS Haines" was commissioned and served throughout the remainder of World War II, performing various duties and earning one Battle Star; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Haines served his country and its citizens with bravery and distinction, and on May 15th, 2010, he was honored as the 2010 Recipient of the Greene County "Honor a Deceased Veteran" Award;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greene County Legislature, in acknowledgment and deep appreciation of his outstanding service to this country and its citizens and for having paid the ultimate price for his patriotism, does hereby designate all of County Route 18 in Haines Falls, New York, as "Lt. Richard A. Haines Memorial Highway."

RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED 6 NYCRR
PART 247 REGULATIONS ON OUTDOOR WOOD BOILERS

Legislator Frey offered the following resolution
and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the price of home heating fuels has skyrocketed over the last few years for citizens within Greene County; and

WHEREAS, outdoor wood boilers (OWBs) can provide a cost effective alternative to fossil fuels; and

WHEREAS, OWBs were not made for, and never should have, any solid waste burned in them; and

WHEREAS, no other State has required that existing OWBs be taken out of service; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation in April, 2010 published and is currently soliciting comments on proposed regulation 6 NYCRR Part 247, Outdoor Wood Boilers; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature does not support the requirements in the proposed DEC Part 247 regulations;

WHEREAS, in addition, the Greene County Legislature considers Municipal Home Rule a highly valued privilege and believes that local governments should be free to exercise that authority; this DEC proposal would preempt local home rule, interfering and removing the ability of local governments to make determinations regarding issues traditionally handled at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislature gives notice of its opposition to DEC's proposal and considers this a threat to Home Rule by infringing on the jurisdiction of local municipal decision making;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greene County Legislature hereby supports efforts to protect the use of properly operated OWBs that are installed and operated properly, and to protect the property rights of those outdoor wood boiler owners; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Greene County Legislature hereby strongly opposes this new proposal and believes that it should be regulated on a local level consistent with local zoning and land use regulations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of the resolution shall be forwarded to Governor David Paterson, Attorney General Andrew Cuomo, United States Senator Charles E. Schumer, New York State Senator James Seward, Assemblyman Peter Lopez, Assemblyman Timothy P. Gordon, all New York State Counties, New York State Association Of Counties, the New York State Association Of Towns, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and all towns and villages within Greene County.

RESOLUTION NO. 232-10

AMENDING AGREEMENT WITH LOCAL 968
AFSCME, AFL-CIO, COUNCIL 66 REGARDING TEMPORARY
CHANGE OF WORK HOURS AND WORK DAYS

Legislator Martinez offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 92-09 adopted on March 18, 2009, the Greene County Legislature authorized an Agreement with Local 968 AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Council 66, covering the years January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, a labor management meeting was held on May 12, 2010 between representatives of the AFSCME Union and the County to discuss a temporary change in work hours and work days from five eight-hour days per week, to four ten-hour days per week, in an effort to increase efficiency and reduce expenses; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Union agree that this work schedule has been implemented previously in 2008 and 2009 and has proven to be beneficial and cost efficient and further agree that the same change in work hours and work days from five eight-hour days, to four ten-hour days per week will be implemented on a temporary basis, effective June 21, 2010 and continue through September 3, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Union agree that during this temporary change, regular work hours for AFSCME employees will be 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and that the Building Supervisors will ensure that the workforce is deployed from the buildings no later than 6:30 a.m. and that work is performed without undue disturbance in populated areas. It is further agreed that work will continue until at least 4:00 p.m. unless it is determined by the Building Supervisor that additional travel time is required to return to the building; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Union agree that in order to provide coverage on Fridays during this temporary change in work schedule, one (1) laborer and one (1) operator will be scheduled to work five eight-hour days from 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. These employees will be selected on a voluntary basis by seniority. If there are an insufficient number of volunteers, this shift will be filled by inverse seniority. No employee will be mandated in excess of four (4) weeks on this shift; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Union agree that use of benefit time will be required for any time not worked and that a day off will equal ten hours of benefit time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature be and hereby is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with Local 968, AFSCME, AFL-CIO Council 66, amending the current contract.

RESOLUTION NO. 236-10

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH THE CATSKILL WATERSHED CORPORATION
FOR MAINTENANCE OF STORMWATER RETROFIT MEASURES

Legislator Gardner offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, as authorized by Resolution 158-04, Greene County entered into a contract with the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) under the Stormwater Retrofit Program for the installation of certain stormwater best management practices (the Stormwater BMPs) in the area of street sweeping and catch basin cleaning (the Project); and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Project is complete and the Stormwater BMPs must be maintained to continue their effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department has created a maintenance manual for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department has already incurred costs for the maintenance of the Stormwater BMPs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.06 and 3.04 of the Stormwater Retrofit Program Contract between CWC and the New York City Department of Environmental Protection, the Greene County Legislature may request the transfer of an amount equal to 17.6% of the funding provided by CWC for the project to Greene County, to be used for the sole purpose of maintaining the Stormwater BMPs, including reimbursement of such costs that have been incurred to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greene County Legislature does request that CWC transfer the sum of \$31,680, representing 17.6% of the funding provided by the CWC pursuant to the Stormwater Retrofit Grant to Greene County, with such funds to be used solely for the maintenance of the Stormwater BMPs, including reimbursement of the costs incurred to date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with CWC for the transfer of \$31,680 to Greene County, subject to approval as to form by the Greene County Attorney.
